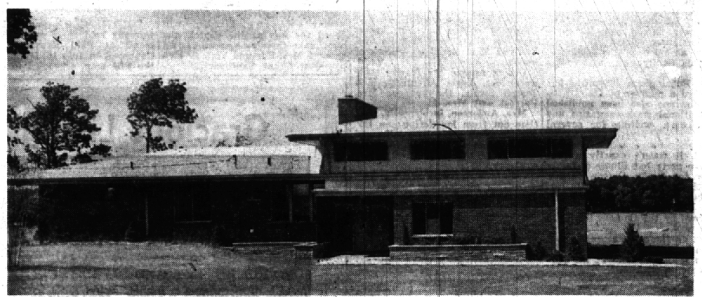
EAST BEVERLY — Colorado

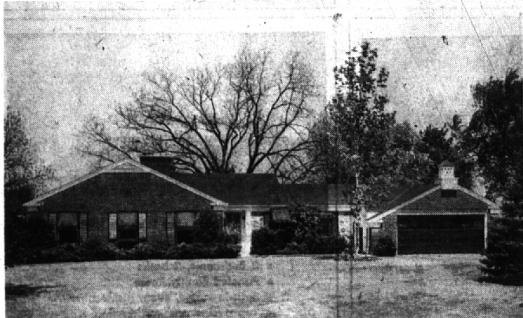
