GRADUATION DAY will be June 8th. Weather permitting, all the ceremonies will be held on the school grounds.

The big evening is June 9th, when each of the honorees, dressed in long ball gowns and gloves, will be escorted to a pre-ball reception given at the Convent by the nuns. They proceeded on to the Latin Quarter, which will be decorated with pink napery. Tall pink tapers on the tables will be circled with garlands of fresh flowers and giant clusters of pink balloons will be overhead.

After the girls and their parents receive their friends, they will be escorted onto the raised dais by their fathers and individually introduced to the gathered assembly.

THE FAREWELL MEDLEY to the school will be the theme of the first cotillion waltz, which will be performed by the girls and their fathers. Then all will join in the dancing. There will be a midnight candlelight supper and more dancing.

After the Ball Mr. and Mrs. Judge W. Bearden and their daughter, Kathleen McLaughlin, will entertain honorees at breakfast on the patio of their Birmingham home.
