May we remind you that:—

1. Early fertilized lawns are about ready for the second application of fertilizer and MERION BLUEGRASS lawns definitely are.

Use 10-6-4 U.F. at 20# per 1000 sq. ft. or Use 7-0-0 at 30# per 100 sq. ft. or Use 5-4-0 at 40# per 1000 sq. ft.

2. A single spray for broadleaved weeds should be made immediately. Spray the entire area with 2,4-D or 2,4-D plus 2,4,5-T at the rate of one gal. of mixture to 200 sq. ft. Put the equipment away and RELAX. (But PLEASE do an honest job!)

3. Spraying of flowers, ornamentals, trees and shrubs should begin right away. For insects and scales use Mc-B INSECT SPRAY or ISOTOX. Also good are Malathion, mixed powders, Tri-Open, etc. But do it thoroughly and regularly. A half-baked job will get you third-baked results.

4. Fruit trees are ready for your best attack when the blossom petals have fallen. Use the MICHIGAN FORMULA or variation under the names McClellan-Ball FRUIT TREE SPRAY or TREE-TOX (liquid formula).
