HEADING the list of displayers is John Tabb, 1566 Bowers, Birmingham, who has had exhibitions in Michigan and Ohio as well as in New York. Tabb has won many gold medals and prizes both in water colors and oils.

Sharing the billing with Tabb will be Ernest W. Seanes of Grosse Pointe, a well-known name in Michigan art circles for more than 20 years. He displayed his work at the New York World's Fair and

in the Chicago Art Institute. Seanes is represented in the permanent collection of Detroit Institute of Arts.

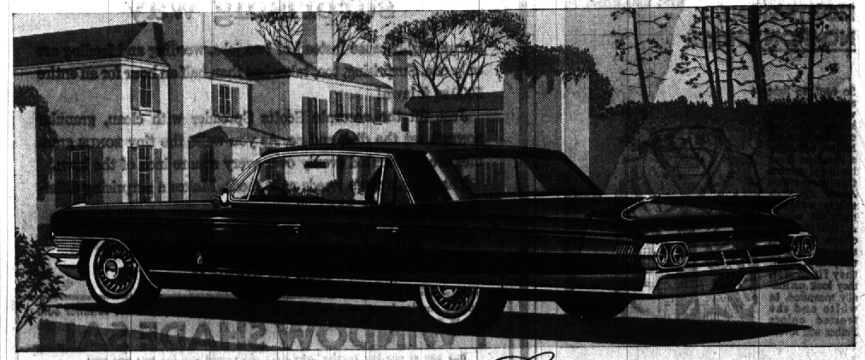
