MANY OF US who have watched the satellite Echo move accross the night sky realize that the project gave America a clear lead in space communications. However, the longer we delay in setting up the first satellite system, the more we risk losing our lead.

The Bell Telephone System has offered to build and

pay for experimental satellites. It is willing to pay for their launching and for the ground stations in the U.S. (Foreign ground stations would be owned by foreign communications agencies.) There would be no cost to the taxpayer.

The Bell System's interest in space stems from the The Bell System's interest in space stems from the fact that a space communications system would be a natural extension of networks used in providing service to the public today. Bell seeks no monopoly and does not wish to exclude other international carriers either from establishing satellite communications systems or from sharing use of the system it proposes. This system would be operated under government regulation just as today's communications systems are operated.

What could offer a better means to serve the pub-'s interest in a broader communications network, tomorrow!
