Promotes Clinics For Polio Vaccine

Polio, at its lowest ebb in more than two decades, is still capable of killing or crippling in 1961. The Reverend G. Burton Hodgson, chair-man of the Oakland Chapter of the National Foundation, warned today.

"Based on last year's experience
and the U. S. Public Health Service tabulations, it is clear that
polio has not yet been beaten as a
mass crippler, despite the fact that
the extremely efficient Salk antipolio vaccine has been available in
this country for the past six years."

IN 1960 almost half the paraly tic cases were babies and children under 5 years, said Rev. Hodgson.

"The truth is that polio out-breaks could be virtually eliminated if people would merely get their full series of Salk shots. Yet, near-ly 86,000,000 Americans under 40 have not taken the time to get even one shot," he said.
