

Freedom Festival 'Follies' Tickets At Demery's Here

The world-famous "Water Follies of 1961", world's largest water and stage show, which is being brought to this year's International Freedom Festival as a July 2-3-4 highlight event, has been announced by Detroit's Mayor Louis C. Miriani.

Ticket sales have started and may be obtained at the Convention Arena box office in Detroit, or at the first-floor S&H stamp counter at Demery's - Birmingham, Wood-

ward at Hamilton. Cost is \$2.50 and \$1.50 with children under 12 years at half-price.

The Water Follies of 1961 is the world's largest water and stage show, presently traveling throughout the world. This show was the outstanding entertainment attraction at the Brussels World's Fair, and Oregon Centennial Exposition.

THE COMPLETE show making

its premier appearance in Detroit at the new Civic Center Arena, will put on two performances a day on July 2, 3, and 4. One of the performances each day will be a music show. The times of the two shows each day will be announced later.

The Water Follies, which is expected to play to a capacity audience in its 6 performances, could not be booked in for a longer time, due to previous booking of the Arena by the National Square Dance Convention. It is hoped to make this Water Follies an annual event, and for a longer period. Two of the major Festivals in the country utilize a similar show as a major attraction. They include the Minneapolis Aquatennial and the Seattle Sea Fair.

THE WATER Follies is a novel and exciting show, entirely different to that of any previous show seen here. It ranks as one of the four top shows in America. It is a combined musical revue in water

and on stage that is fast-moving, has a running time of two hours, contains 10 water scenes and seven lavish stage numbers.

It was in the Water Follies of 1957 that Eleanor Holm, famed Olympic Star turned professional, made her debut.

The Water Follies is presented in the world's largest portable pools and stage, 150 feet long and 35 feet wide. It contains a total of about 50,000 gallons of water.

The water portion of the Water Follies features such great aquatic names as Stanley Mitchell, world's greatest acrobatic diver, Roger Nadeau, world's greatest water comedian; Clive Dyson, former Australian diving champion; Bobby James, former National AAU Diving Champion. The famed Water Ballet will make two appearances throughout the show.

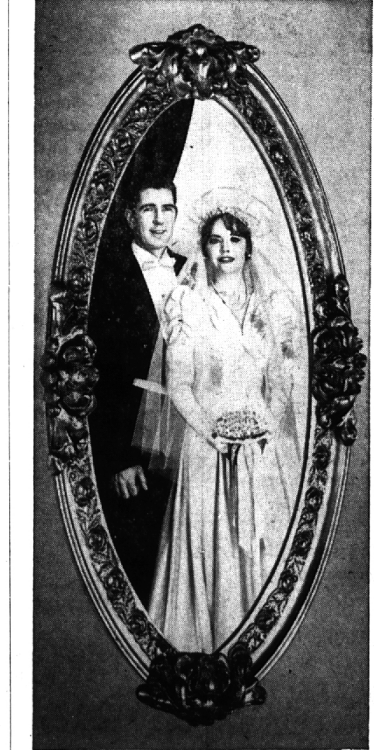

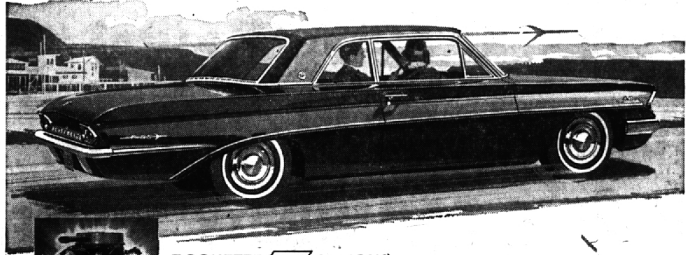
