The Michigan State Highway Department will open bids Wednesday on 41 highway construction projects with an estimated contract value of \$16 million.

Included among the contracts is 7.8 miles of Interstate 696 Freeway in Oakland County.

A total of 5.4 miles of I-696 will be from the Interstate 66 Freeway west of Haggerty Road northwest of Farmington east to Orchard Lake Road.

Another 2.4 mile portion of I-696 is from Orchard Lake Road east to Franklin Road.

Completion dates for both projects is Nov. 30, 1962.
