gets its name from the Ukrainian national instrument, the bandura, has been acclaimed internationally. A Danish critic called them "the most professional chorus in the world."

Wednesday night's feature will be "The Golden Age of Comedy," a film reviewing the art and humor of pioneer filmdom's immortal clowns such as Harold Lloyd, Charlie Chaplin, Will Rogers and Laurel and Hardy.

Poetry takes front and center Thursday night when Pulitzer-prize-winning W. D. Snodgrass reads from his book of poems, "Heart's Needle." The Wayne State University instructor will be joined on the stage by local poetry lovers reading their favorites.

In a moderated discussion, participants will interpret their selections. Snodgrass,

for the first time publicly, will reveal some new ideas on developments in poetry.

Another about face on the dome platform will take place when jazz artists take the fore Friday and Saturday nights. Two afternoon matinees will satisfy gourmets and the younger set. A "Gourmet Matinee" Wednesday at 2:30 will be conducted by Philip Velez, the famous executive chef of the London Chop House and the Caucus Club.

Thursday at 2 p.m. the Vanguard Players will entertain children with their new production, "Bumbles." John Gregory appears in the title role of the musical comedy with songs by Mort Zieve and lyrics by Rudy Simon.

Evening events will begin at 8:40 p.m. except for the Wednesday movie which starts at 9 p.m.

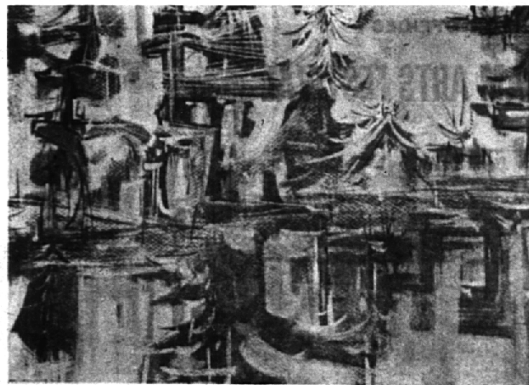
