"TRAVELING IS A favorite pastime for Delov and me," said Colbert—who still retains his Texas drawl even after nearly 30 years as a Yankee.

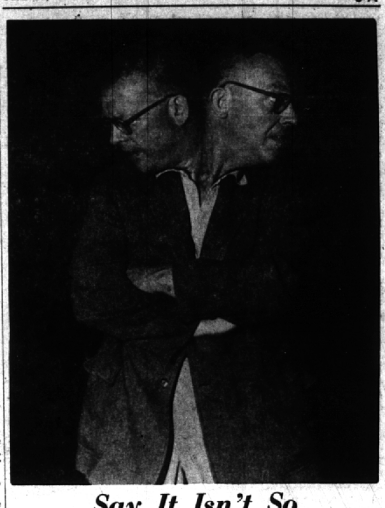
BOTH ENJOY reading for relaxation and education. Colbert is principally a newspaper reader, but keeps up with the latest magazines.
