LAWNS: If you haven't already done so, (and most of you haven't) this coming week-end should be excellent in point of time and the availability of manpower to activate the spreader to fertilize the lawn for the second time. Use AGRICO U.F., AGRINITE, OR REGAL ORGANIC. Sprinkling—follow the instructions in the McClellan-Ball (FREE) LAWN CARE GUIDE—Water infrequently and deep.

BUGS AND SUCH—Rose Chafer Beetles may be killed with ISOTOX or MALATHION. The "two-Brick" method is outmoded. Spray about every 4 days as long as beetles continue to show up. Pine Shoot Moths should be sprayed now with DDT and/or MALATHION to kill the adult egg-laying moth. Scale—the little brown blobs on the underside of the twigs of trees, shrubs and evergreens will hatch soon. Keep an eye on them. When you see little white specks on the twig near the little brown blobs, the crawlers are beginning to emerge. Spray within a week with ISOTOX or MALATHION.

ROSES—regular spraying with a combination of ISOTOX and PHALTAN will prevent damage from bugs, black spot, and mildew. Spray at one week to 10 day intervals. Should aphids appear in between times a quick shot of Rose Dust will do the job. When spraying get the under-side of the leaves and the ground around the plant in particular. "US BUGS HATE ORTHO."

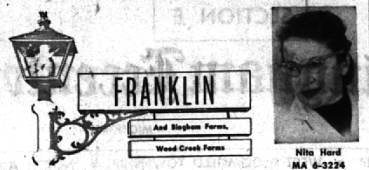

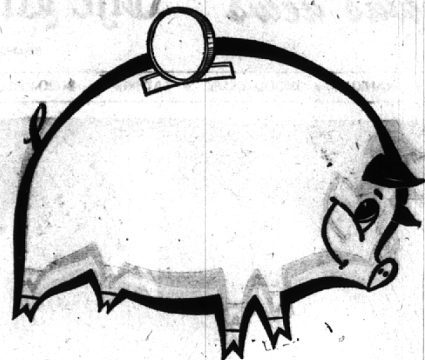
