Shopping Center Proposal May Go to Court

SOUTHFIELD—Possible court battle over a rezoning matter was indicated when Jacob Rose of J and W Builders and the Southfield Development Co. said he is going to take the city to court. The council on June 19 turned down a 2 1/2-year-old request for rezoning of a nine-acre site at 13 Mile and Southfield Road for a neighborhood shopping center. The council has sent two other proposals for shopping centers to the Planning Commission. One is for a center, proposed by Woodrow Nelson, located at 12 Mile and Evergreen Roads.

THE SECOND proposal is for a 26-acre "Village Center" at 12 1/2 Mile and Southfield Roads, proposed by Rodney Lockwood. The center was approved by council, 4 to 3, in February, 1960 but was vetoed by Donald L. Swanson, then mayor. Nelson's proposal was turned down by council at about the same time. The board of directors of the Cranbrook subdivision oppose the smaller sites saying they want a large center.

A fourth shopping center has been proposed for 11 Mile Road and Lahser. Council has approved rezoning of the property from residential to neighborhood shopping. Residents in the area have expressed objections to the zoning change as has Mayor S. James Clarkson.

Southfield Given 10 Days to Move Fire Station

SOUTHFIELD—A temporary fire station, at the northeast corner of 12 Mile Road and Lahser, has been ordered moved by a June 19 court order, secured by former Councilwoman Jean McDonnell and her husband, Wayne. Under the court order, the city was given ten days to move the station from the McDonnell property. The temporary fire station consists of a garage that houses the truck and a rented house trailer in which two firemen on duty stay. The fire station site was originally leased from the McDonnells for \$1, for one year only. The lease, expiring in April, 1960, was not renewed according to City Clerk Patrick Flannery. The McDonnell's court order was secured after the city kept the temporary station on their property without payment of rent.

Lathrup Adds New Policeman to Force

LATHRUP—The city's newest policeman, William Leroy Smith, 30, of Utica, will assume his duties Saturday, the start of Lathrup's fiscal year. Smith was chosen from about 150 persons applying for the job. Ten were interviewed, according to Police Chief Thomas A. Telfer. HE IS THE fourth full-time policeman to be added to the Lathrup force. A native of Detroit, he is married and has one daughter. A military policeman for nine of the ten years he was in the Army, from 1947 to 1957, Smith also served a year as a policeman in Monrovia, Calif. He has been a truck driver in Detroit for the last three years.

SOUTHFIELD COUNCIL, on June 19, decided to start condemnation proceedings on a lot across 12 Mile from the temporary site but delayed the order until June 30 Friday of this week.

The delay was aimed at giving residents a chance to persuade the Detroit Edison Co. to switch location of a substitution it plans to build on one of two lots the company own across from the temporary fire station. Residents prefer to have a new fire station built on the lot proposed for the substitution. The city hopes to negotiate an extension of the lease with the McDonnells until a new station is constructed. If forced to abandon the temporary station, fire insurance rates may be raised for property owners in the area. CITY ADMINISTRATOR Donald V. Smith said that old plans
