"A performance by the U. of Iowa string quartet last Friday night climaxed a one-week music festival presented by the young but extremely ambitious music department of the Oklahoma branch of MSU. In spite of the unfavorable acoustic and atmospheric conditions the performance was a musical treat to be remembered. The mastery ensemble technique, the flawless pitch and unity of concept of these four virtuosos became evident as soon as they opened the program. Paul Olefsky, formerly first cellist with the Detroit symphony, played with unbelievable sensitivity, beauty and control of tone. His pianissimo projected well and his pizzicatos were of a rare resonant quality. It was interesting to observe that an American quartet can well rank with the best of European ensembles."
