

Road Improvement Plans Get Approval From B'field Board

BLOOMFIELD TOWNSHIP.—The Township Board accepted a petition Monday night for road improvement of Kirkway Drive, Apple Lane, Blossom Lane and Island Lane.

The roads are to be blacktopped at an estimated cost of \$40,000.

THE BOARD also held a first hearing on a road improvement project for Long Lake Shores Drive, at a cost of \$15,000. With the petition signed by 80 per cent of the residents, and no objections raised at the hearing, the board directed preparation of a special assessment roll.

Southfield Council Approves Increase In 1960-61 Budget

SOUTHFIELD—Final approval was given Monday by the City Council to an upward adjustment of the 1960-61 budget, of about \$41,000.

The increase was necessary because of under-estimates in the city's payroll account and road maintenance fund.

ABOUT \$40,000 of the road fund underestimate was provided for last month when council increased that part of the budget by that amount. Funds came from anticipated increase in state gas and weight tax rebates.

Payroll accounts required additional funds due to an extra pay day in the fiscal year. The first payroll fell on the first day of the fiscal year, July 1, 1960; the last will coincide with the final day of the year.

AN ADDITIONAL \$18,000 was needed to cover salary increases since July 1. Only \$2,000 out of \$20,000 was set aside.

State tax refunds will take care of part of the increase in the budget; the balance will come from increases in revenue.
