Newberg Takes Job With Rochester Firm

"The next step was to get back into action. So here I am," William C. Newberg says of his return to work for the first time since leaving Chrysler Corp. last June 30. Newberg, former president of Chrysler, has been engaged by the Detroit Broach and Machine Co., a Rochester firm, with offices and a main plant on Rochester Road, south of the village. The company also has a factory at Greer, S.C. Newberg's employment is on a "short term basis," subject to 90-day termination notice, said Gustaf von Reis, president of Detroit Broach.

He said the action was the first step in a proposed expansion of the company. Newberg will devote his efforts primarily, though not exclusively, to setting the company's new program into motion, von Reis said.

"AT THE SAME time he will lay the groundwork for the second phase of the program, namely, diversification within the company's general field," von Reis explained.

The association will call for a major portion of Newberg's time in the early stages of the program, according to von Reis.

Newberg said he had investigated many offers before deciding on his new job. The amount of salary was not disclosed.

Von Reis said he was "extremely gratified in being able to obtain the services of a man with Newberg's engineering, production, and management skills."

THE FIRM employs 400 people and specializes in the design and manufacture of broaching machines, tools and fixtures, in addition to specialized presses. The Rochester and Greer plants will undergo changes, enabling the company to handle "at least a 75 per cent increase in volume," von Reis said.
