The various faculty and Board members have given this every-impresed with the feeling that questions asked are answered by the intelligence level of a high and dedicated pattern.

With the ever-increasing student body of 25,000 students) there continues to arise the problem of housing them, university to university, and dormitories and fraternity and other housing, plus many private homes, are the students of the Board discussed the idea of holding apartment-type dormitories, where small groups of boys or girls may be located separately in their own housekeeping environment. 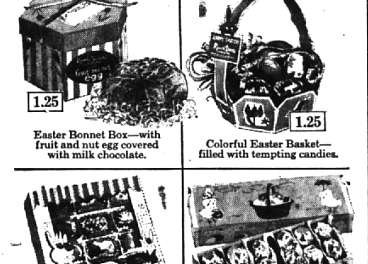
