

Dickerson Named To Head Committee

James P. Dickerson of Birmingham has been named chairman of the Oakland County "Dethmers-Kelly Re-election Committee." Supreme Court Justice John R. Kelly announced recently. Chief Justice Dethmers and Justice Kelly are campaigning for re-election to the Supreme Court in the April 3 spring election. They were re-nominated by the Republican State Convention but their names appear on the separate non-partisan judicial ballot in the April 3 election.

Commenting on his acceptance of the Oakland County chairmanship, James P. Dickerson said: "The judicial branch of our government is the ultimate protector of our rights and liberties. A judiciary independent of special interest pressures and controls is an absolute necessity. Both Chief Justice Dethmers and Justice Kelly have demonstrated their integrity, their ability and their devotion to the concept of a government by law, not government by men. Their re-election to the Supreme Court is essential to the best interests of Michigan."

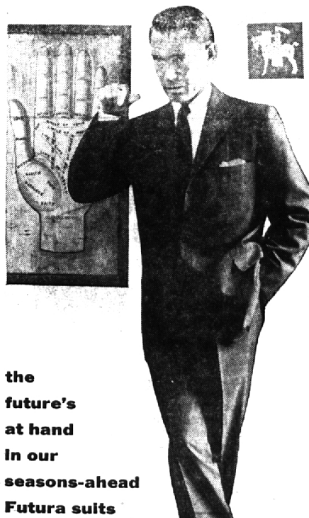
