Classroom Shortage Serious, Survey Says

Pupil enrollment in Michigan's public elementary and secondary schools is steadily increasing, while classroom shortage is growing more serious, the research division of the Michigan Education Association (MEA) announced.
 Results of a survey released by the MEA show that 1,675,000 pupils are now enrolled in Michigan's public elementary and secondary schools, as compared to the 1,624,000 pupils who were enrolled in 1959.
 Nationally, public school enrollments increased to a record 86.3 million pupils this year, the U. S. Office of Education reports. This is an increase of more than one million over last year.
 Michigan's classroom shortage totals 10,782 additional rooms needed. Of this total, 8,831 classrooms are needed to replace obsolete facilities and 1,951 are needed to accommodate excess enrollments. The Michigan classroom shortage figure is high compared to states

with similar pupil enrollments. Classroom shortage in the nation's public schools rose from 135,000 to 142,100 during the past year. The shortage eliminates 65,141 classrooms needed to relieve overcrowding and 76,019 to replace unsatisfactory facilities.
 The MEA survey indicates also that Michigan's total number of public elementary and secondary school teachers has increased more than 4,000 in the past year—from 60,400 in 1959 to 64,500 in 1960.

NATIONALLY, the number of classroom teachers rose to 1,410,000 including 861,000 in elementary schools and 549,000 in the secondary schools. This is 55,000 more than last year's total.

Michigan's total number of teachers, with substandard certification remains about the same. Presently there are 6,938 teachers in Michigan (exclusive of Detroit) under substandard certification—6,199 on the elementary level and 1,169 on the secondary level.
