Hull to Attend Management Course



AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 20 ENTI-TLED "AN ORDINANCE RECULATING AND RESTRICTING THE HEIGHT, INCHRED OF STORIES AND SIZE OF BUILD-INCS, THE SIZE OF OPEN SPACES, THE DENSITY OF POP-LATION, THE LOCATION OF STORIES AND SIZE OF POPULATIONS THE LOCATION OF SIZE O

The Village of Beverly Hills Ordains:

The Village of Beverly Hills Ordains:
Section 1.01. That Ordinance No. 20 entitled "An Ordinance Regulating and Restricting the Height, Number of Stories and Size of Buildings; The Size of Open Spaces; The Density of Population; The Location and Use of Buildings and Land for Trade, Residence and Other Purposes; Creating Districts for said Purposes and Establishing the Boundaries Thereof; Providing for Changes in Regulations and Boundaries of Such Districts; Defining Certain Terms Used Herein; Providing for Enforcement; Establishment of a Zoning Board of Appeals; and Imposing Penalties for the Violation of this Ordinance" be and the same hereby is amended by amending the Zone Map attached thereto and made a part thereof as follows:

Beginning at a point on the East line of Section 2, 283 feet North of the Southeast corner of Section 2, T I N, R 10 E, thence North 22.17, feet allong the East line of Section 2, thence South 89° 42° 00° West 324 feet, thence South 570 feet parallel with the East line of Section 2, thence South east-cry 10° U₂ between North 88° 29° East 283 feet to the point of degrating.

Beginning at a point 282 feet. West of the Southeast car-bein 3 feet in 2. T. N. S. In P. S. on the South Boof 5 feet for 2. thence West 202 feet along the South line of Section 2, thence North 333 feet, thence East 1D feet parallel with the South line of Section 2, thence South-easterly 70 feet, thence North 283 feet to the point of beginning.
