MRS. KENNETH KESLER and Mrs. William Hohmeyer will attend the Junior convention with their daughters.

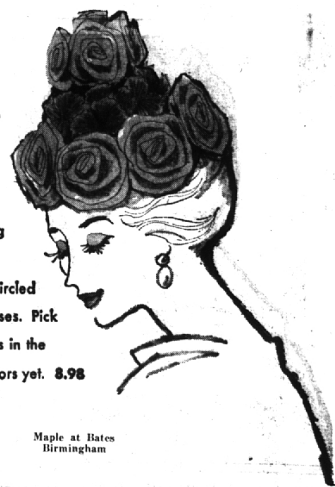

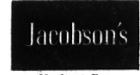
Vacationing in Arizona are the George Tischer, Ernest Breches, Robert Fishers and J. A. Frosts.
