Skipper of the Skate To Speak at Meeting

John Crosby, internationally syndicated "Critic at Large" for the New York Herald Tribune, who was scheduled to speak at the April 5 annual dinner meeting of the Village Woman's Club will be unable to attend.

Guest speaker at the club's annual dinner meeting at Bloomfield Hills Country Club will be Captain James Calvert, U.S.N., Naval officer who successfully led the U.S.S. Skate in one of the most daring voyages in history, repeatedly surfacing through the frozen Arctic icecap.

CAPTAIN Calvert is an Annapolis graduate, Class of 1942, and a submarine veteran of World War II, when he was twice awarded the Silver Star and Bronze Star.

For his achievement on the Skate, he was twice awarded the Legion of Merit and the submarine was honored with the only two Navy Unit Commendations ever given in peacetime. He now commands Submarine Division 102, which includes all of the Atlantic Fleet nuclear submarines.

HE LIVES in Mystic, Conn., with his wife and three children. Captain Calvert will discuss his difficult missions as well as the future possibilities of nuclear submarines.

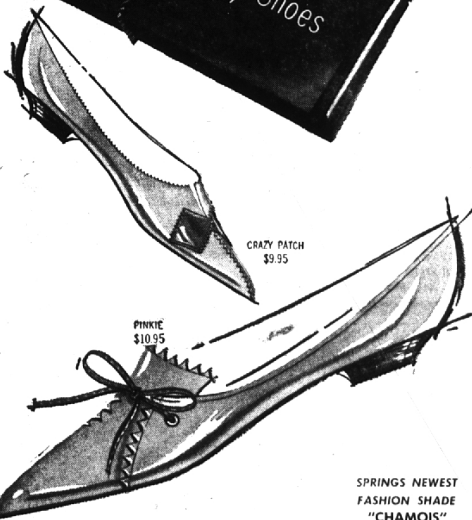
