And speaking of the Zetyes, The Eccentric went to press practically on the heels of the arrival of their new twin daughters, so a report is "due on the babies' names.

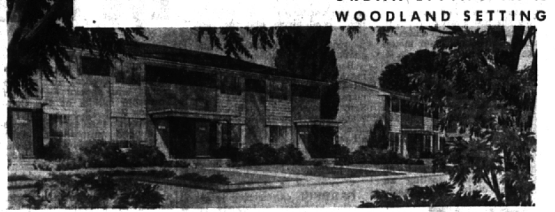
The little girls will be known henceforth as Madeline Anne and

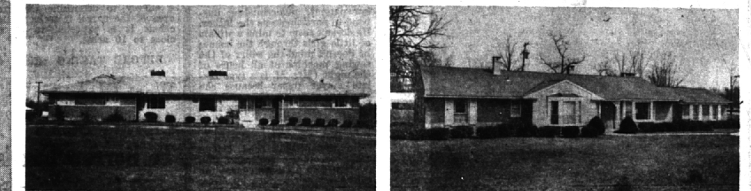

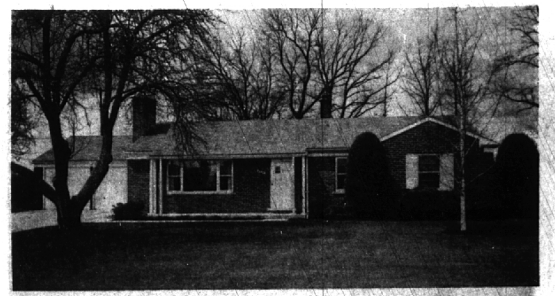
