The May Current Population Survey will include special questions on ownership of automobiles, home freezers, automatic clothes dryers and television sets in addition to the regular inquiries on employment and unemployment. It was announced today by Director John E. Thurston of the U.S. Census Bureau's regional field office at Detroit.

The number of television sets per household is being obtained at the request of the Advertising Research Foundation.

The information on automobiles, freezers and clothes dryers is being collected for the Household Economics Research Division of the U.S. Department of Agriculture for use in a study of life rates for selected, durable goods.
