THE 49-YEAR-OLD Newberg climbed to the presidency after 27 years with the company. He resigned last June after only 60 days as president on charges that his interest in two supplier firms conflicted with his position at Chrysler.

Newberg's petition alleges that "L. L. Colbert (of Bloomfield Hills) conspired to destroy Newberg professionally and thereby elimi-nate him as a threat to Colbert's continuation as Chrysleg's chief executive."

Colbert is Chrysler's president nd board chairman.

Prominent Chrysler directors are amed in the petition as "co-onspirators."

Several stockholder suits against Chrysler and congressional atten-tion followed the Newberg action. Newberg, a graduate engineer om the University of Washing-on, is now a consultant for Detroit roach and Machine Co. of Roches-ir.
