Oakdale Vacation Delayed; Knox Rezoning Approved

Birmingham city commissioners postponed the public hearing Monday night on a proposed to vacate Oakdale south of Ridgedale. Commissioners postponed their decision to give Detroit Edison a chance to secure easement rights. City Manager L. R. Gare recommended vacating the portion of Oakdale in the Ridgedale Park Subdivision immediately south of Ridgedale, as proposed by the city plan board.

This would close up Oakdale and provide protection to property along Ridgedale, Gare explained. But he felt that the easterly 30 feet of the southernmost portion should not be vacated until definite use is established for it.

The POPPLETON Subdivisions Association, representing property owners in the area, endorsed the proposed vacating.

However, a spokesman for the group requested at Monday night's meeting that a pedestrian passage way be retained to allow access from homes to parking lots in the Barton commercial establishments fronting on Maple.

failed to materialize at Tuesday's board of supervisors meeting.

Supervisors appointed John C. Austin, 67 of Lake Orion, as chairman of the auditors to succeed Robert Y. Moore on Jan. 1.

Moore, 76, had submitted his resignation from the board with the understanding that he would be appointed to a newly created position, budget director. But he changed his mind and withdrew the resignation.

He still has two years of his term to serve as a member of the board of auditors. A chairman is appointed each year.

Nothing was done at Tuesday's meeting about naming a budget director.

ROBERT E. LILLY, only Democrat among the auditors, had campaigned for the chairmanship. He and Austin were the only two nominated Tuesday.

Austin drew 50 votes and Lilly 21. Moore got two even though he was not nominated.

There were 34 supervisors present.

Lilly was reappointed to his \$12,700-a-year job as secretary of the auditors.

Supervisor Carl Ingraham from Birmingham had asked for complete reports in regard to the auditor-budget director proposal, and protested when it was submitted to the full board of supervisors without prior information being made available.

The reports were not forthcoming.

IN OTHER ACTION Tuesday, the board of supervisors:

Approved a \$6 million bond issue to help finance the county road commission's primary road improvement program. Total cost of the project is \$11 million. Main roads connecting with freeways now under construction will be improved.

Decided to put up for sale the old county courthouse and prosecutor's office at Saginaw and Huron in Pontiac and other county property, including a house in Birmingham.

Appointed John E. Madole, 44, Pontiac, to replace Lewis C. Jarrendt as county civil defense director. Jarrendt had been under criticism of the supervisor's Civil Defense Committee.

Instructed Madole to locate public or private buildings which might serve as mass fallout shelters.

Kirvan, Ferry Get Con-Con Publicity Jobs

A Birmingham man last week was named assistant director of public information for the Constitutional Convention.

He is Stuart Kirvan, 42, of 696 Hanna, a partner in a Detroit public relations firm.

A partisan battle kept the position from Charles A. Ferry, former public relations officer for the Republican Central Committee of Oakland County. He was later named research assistant on a vote that followed party lines.

Ferry lives in Rochester.

Kirvan will assist the committee on public information and its chairman, delegate Ink White (R., St. Johns). Kirvan's job will pay \$1,000 a month, the same pay as delegates receive.
