

St. James To Establish Day School

St. James Episcopal Church will inaugurate an 18-week day school for pre-school children Jan. 15. The sessions will be held from 9 to 11 a.m. Three-year-old children will attend Tuesday and Thursday and four-year-olds on Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

Tuition for the 18-week semester will be \$30 for three-year-olds and \$75 for four-year-olds. In addition, a \$5 registration fee will be charged.

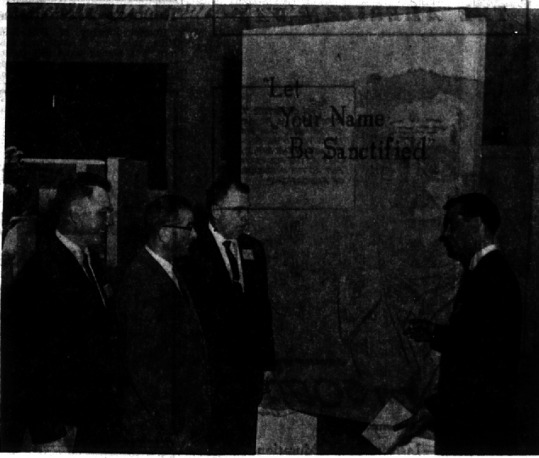
ENROLLMENT WILL BE LIMITED to 15 three-year-olds and 20 four-year-olds on a first come first served basis. Applications for enrollment and inquiries regarding the school may be made through the St. James Church Office.

Mrs. Richard LaFever, 18263 Buckingham, Beverly Hills, will be the teacher for the school. A Yale University graduate, Mrs. LaFever holds a Master's degree in Child Development.

Program director will be Mrs. Thomas Draper, 111 Abbey, Birmingham, who has a Bachelor's degree in pre-school education from the National College of Education in Evanston, Ill.

ALTHOUGH THE SCHOOL will not be directly affiliated with St. James' cooperative school program, mothers will be required to assist three mornings a semester.

The school will be under the auspices of St. James Church and responsible to a board of directors. The school will receive its license from the State Department of Education Dec. 1.
