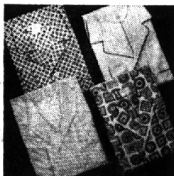

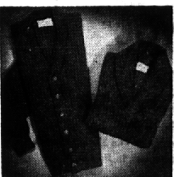

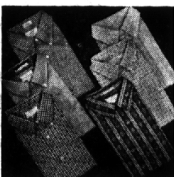

### ACF-Wrigley Sales Staff Changes Name To Allied

Shareholders of ACF-Wrigley Stores, Inc. have agreed to change the corporation's name to Allied Supermarkets, Inc. It was announced by James Cooke, chief executive officer. The action was taken at the corporation's annual meeting of shareholders held recently in Detroit.

The proposal to change the name was submitted by management as more appropriate to the company's business because it better describes the alliance of several local and regional supermarket chains which has formed the basis of the present corporate structure, and the company's plans to expand in similar directions.

It was felt also that the "Wrigley" portion of the former name gave prominence to one company division over the others. The "ACF" portion of the old name referred to a former corporation association which no longer existed.

The present trade names of the stores in the company's divisions will be retained, including Wrigley Supermarkets in Michigan and the Ideal Stores in Kansas, Oklahoma and Texas; the Humpty-Dumpty stores in Oklahoma; the Bettendorf and Rapp Stores in Missouri and the Wrigley Stores in the Greater Dallas-Fort Worth area in Texas.

### Berry to Manage Assembly Plant

Appointment of John H. Berry, 16100 Buckingham, Beverly Hills, as manager of the Plymouth-Detroit assembly plant of Chrysler Corp. was announced recently by G. H. Stover, general plants manager of the company's car and truck assembly group.

Prior to this appointment, Berry was production manager of the St. Louis assembly plant. He joined Chrysler's in 1956 as a production superintendent at the Los Angeles assembly plant. Three years later he transferred to the newly-opened St. Louis plant as night production manager, the position he held until his last appointment in January.

Before joining Chrysler, Berry had several years of experience in both automotive and aircraft production work.

### Walker Announces European Change

Kent-Moore Organization International, A.G., subsidiary of Kent-Moore, Warren, Mich., has announced the moving of their offices to Aegerstrasse 57 Zurich, Switzerland.

### Lower Price Of Seat Belts

Ford Motor Co. announced that it has reduced the suggested retail price of its seat belts.

J. O. Wright, 6100 Wing Lake, Bloomington, Township vice president-car and truck group, said the price reduction is the company's latest effort to promote the use of the safety device. Ford began promoting seat belts and offering them as accessories for all of its automobiles in 1955.

Attachment points that make it convenient for the customer to install eyebolts for front seat belts are standard on all 1962 Ford Motor Co. cars.

Ford belts meet or exceed the strength requirements of the U.S. Government's General Services Administration, the Society of Automotive Engineers and the Federal Aviation Authority, and are actually being tested in actual crashes conducted as part of the company's program to build safety into its automobiles.

Ford belts are available in nine colors—red, black, gray, tan, dark brown, green, light blue, dark blue and white.
