

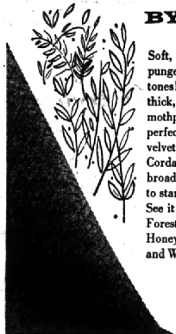
Retirement Village Providing housing for retired teachers in Michigan is the aim of a proposed retirement village, named "Maha Village" which has been organized by the Michigan Education Home Association. To be built near Ann Arbor, the village is designed to establish housing facilities for retired personnel of Michigan public schools and colleges. Initially about 500 persons will be accommodated by the village which is scheduled to be completed in the fall of 1965. "Maha Village" will provide the residents with recreational, civic, cultural, and educational opportunities, along with such physical benefits as complete medical care.



Some 1,300 pounds of teaching materials are on their way to Panama as a result of the Michigan Department of Classroom Teachers "Teacher-to-Teacher" program for the promotion of international understanding. The teaching materials will be used in 11 Panamanian schools.

Wall Closet Fine to Hang Kids' Duds

Instead of having grade school children take their coats and hats into the house at noon or after school, they'll find it more fun if you establish a "wall closet" in the back entry or hallway. Tracking of dirt or snow will be kept to a minimum, as the exposed closet can have a place for not only coats, caps, hats, mittens and leggings, but rubbers and overshoes.

A LOW-HANGING piece of Masonite Peg-Board, fastened to the wall over furring strips so there'll be room for the hooks to hold the garments, takes little room but serves beautifully for the garments. On the floor, to hold wet footwear, put down a strip of Tempered Presdwood, which is moisture resistant.

Spark the youngsters' interest in using their "wall closet" by priming and then colorfully painting the Peg-Board panel and then giving each youngster a space, marking his name over it.

THIS HANDY open-air closet will allow the garments to dry out. It will help teach children orderliness and will save Mother considerable work. Be sure the area is well lighted and the switch can be reached easily.

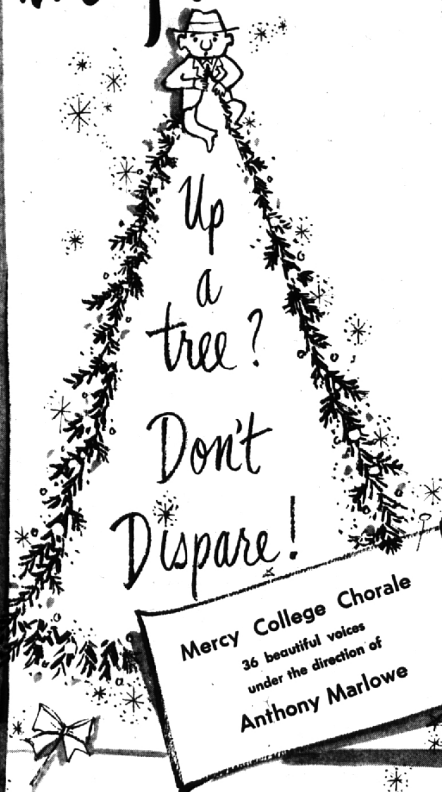
