It is imperative to generate a sense of urgency," Birmingham City Commissioner Robert Page declared Monday night.

He asked the city administration to get copies of the city's disaster preparedness plan "into the hands of the commissioners at the earliest possible date."

City Manager L. R. Gars said commissioners would have copies by the end of this week so that they may discuss the plan at next week's meeting.

Tentative approval to the plan has been granted by the state, explained Assistant City Manager R. S. Kenning, local civil defense director.

Birmingham is one of the 16 governmental units to benefit from the building of these drains which will serve an area of approximately 37 square miles. Birmingham's share is \$1,963,857.71 of a total project cost of \$47,500,000, the City to pay its share from the proceeds of this bond issue plus cash on hand.
