Matthew Cammareri came to Birmingham 30 years ago. A tailor by trade, he opened a small shop upstairs over what is now the Triangle Furniture's location on Woodward on Oct. 5, 1925.

A year later he moved to his present tailor shop at 288 E. Maple (Matthew's Custom Tailors). He has remained at this location ever since 1925, except for a one year period when he tried the North side of Maple.

Cammareri also operated a dry cleaning business for 24 years, employing some 24 people. The cleaning division was separated from the tailor shop, and was located on the corner where The Sportsman now stands.

In 1925, the genial tailor recalls, the city hall, and the police and fire departments, were located at Woodward and E. Maple—where Cunningham's is now located. The Brigg's Building had not yet been built.

Through the years, Cammareri has counted many headline names among his loyal clientele, patrons who more often than not became his good friends. The Lindberg and Saarinen families were examples. His close relationship to the father and son Saarinen architectural team created a deep sense of personal loss following the recent death of Eero Saarinen.

May we add our own personal congratulations to Matthew Cammareri on the completion of his 36th year of service to the people of Birmingham!

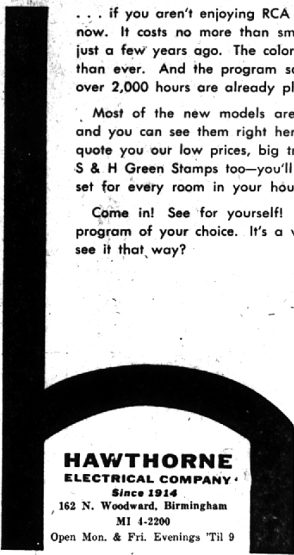
