

# Art Academy Pays Tribute To Sculptor

Cranbrook Academy of Art has published a book entitled "Miles Forward" as a tribute to the late sculptor Carl Milles. A resident artist at the academy for 20 years, the famous Swedish-American sculptor died Sept. 19, 1955. He created some of his most notable works while at the academy. The book is a picture study of some of these works, but as the forward points out, "it is not a critique of Milles' work, nor is it an attempt to analyze his style and technique or judge his influence on the world of sculpture."

CRANBROOK HAS the largest collection of Milles' work in the world outside his own home in Lidings, Sweden, which is now a national museum.

Photographs of the Cranbrook collection were taken by Cranbrook photographers Richard Askew, Harvey Gross, Joe Munro, James Packard and Joy Griffin West.

"Milles at Cranbrook" was printed by the Cranbrook Press and is on sale for \$5 in the Cranbrook Academy of Art Galleries and the Cranbrook Institute of Science.

Street vigorously protested any rezoning of lots on the east side of Ann Street, from multiple dwelling to business property, it was indicated in arguments presented before the City Commission Monday evening. A spokesman for the property owners protested the rezoning which had been requested in a petition from the Northwest Chevrolet Co., Detroit.

By a vast majority, the members of the Birmingham Veterans' Organization voted to turn thumbs down, in the coming November election, on the State amendment providing a bonus for the veterans of Michigan. Robert Savard, the organization's president announced that this action was the result of a discussion at the veterans' October meeting held last Thursday.

Creation of a separate recreation board for the city of Birmingham moved nearer reality Monday evening when the City Commission approved a resolution of intent for the establishment of such a board.

## B'ham Cites Violators of Open Parking

Seven violations of Birmingham's open parking stations (parking lots, privately operated and open to the public) ordinance were cited at the commission meeting Oct. 2.

City Manager L. E. Gary and building inspector Andrew F. Butt reported that owners of the lots involved have been notified of the violations.

They said new notices will be sent giving them until Oct. 20 to correct the violations; if not corrected, legal action will be instituted.

- 4) Parking lot to the rear of Green's, 420 S. Woodward, surfacing.
- 5) Parking lot to the north of Adams Village Market at Lincoln and Adams, surfacing and drainage.
- 6) Redeemer Lutheran Church on W. Maple, partially completed zoning ordinance screening requirements.
- 7) Parking lot adjoining Uncle John's Pancake House, 1358 S. Woodward, drainage.

## Cigarettes vs. Health

*Q. Is lung cancer directly related to smoking?*

A. The American Cancer Society supported statistical studies that show an association between smoking, lung cancer, and shortened life. The U.S. Public Health Service Chief said in 1959: "The weight of evidence is increasingly pointing in one direction: that excessive smoking is one of the causative factors in lung cancer." The final answer is yet to come. The tobacco industry and other groups have spent millions to prove or disprove a link between smoking and cancer, but research has still not provided a clear-cut answer.

**Rapid Sobering-Up**

*Q. Is there a way to sober-up quickly?*

A. Rapid sobering-up from the drunken state is not easily achieved. In fact, it must be admitted that at the present time there is no certain way of rendering a drunken person sober and socially acceptable any more quickly than there is no "treatment" attempted.

**Late Development**

*Q. My 17-year-old son is physically very immature. His brother started developing at about 14. What would you advise?*

A. In most places the legal age of puberty (the state of physical development when it is first possible to beget or bear children) is fixed at fourteen for boys and twelve for girls. However, "growing up" doesn't follow man-made laws and it is not so unusual for puberty to be delayed to age 17 or, rarely, even beyond. Development may then be natural and progress normally. Late maturity may be a sort of family characteristic but it would be best to have the 17-year-old examined by a physician. If any reason can be found for the delay, treatment may then be begun without further delay.
