Oak Street Bridge Open In Birmingham

The new Oak St. bridge in Birmingham was opened to traffic Monday.

Cost of the single-span, girder oak bridge with standard highway department railings, was estimated at \$54,750 by City Engineer William T. Killen.

Included in the project was the paving of Oak from Lakeside to Lakespark (one block) and grading of the sidewalk.

Some landscaping and replanting remains to be done.

KILLEN SAID the Northlawn bridge should be completed in about two weeks. Costing an estimated \$54,750, it is of the same type construction as the Oak St. bridge but has rustic timber railings.

The twin - culvert Willis St. bridge has been opened to traffic since the middle of September, but Killen said some work remains to be completed next year, including sidewalk on the north side. A temporary sidewalk will be installed for the winter.

Its estimated cost is \$40,000. Total estimated cost of all three bridges is \$143,800.

County GOP PR Director Will Resign

Charles A. Ferry, public relations director of the Oakland County Republican organization, will resign his post effective Oct. 15.

Ferry's resignation was announced by Charles L. Lyle, newly elected county GOP chairman, who said the organization's executive committee was accepting it "with deep regret."

Ferry said he plans to return to private business but announced no immediate plans.

Arthur G. Elliott Jr., outgoing GOP chairman who recruited Ferry to the post, said "Mr. Ferry is one of the most effective public relations men the party has ever had. His services will be sorely missed."

FERRY, WHO HAS been publicly critical of his party, was co-author of a broad reorganization plan recently endorsed by the GOP state central committee. He joined the Oakland GOP in August of 1960 and was a key figure in the organization's highly successful presidential, biennial spring election and Con-Con election campaigns.

A former newspaper reporter and free-lance writer, Ferry has worked as public relations and advertising consultant in recent years.
