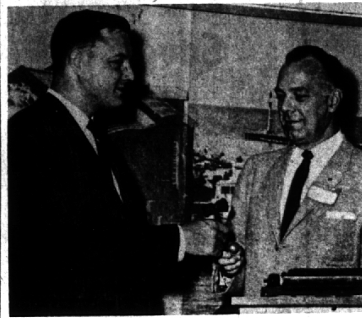

Booth Named Fisher Body Finance Head

The appointment of Charles V. Booth, 846 Fairfax, Birmingham, to the newly created position of finance manager of Fisher Body division was announced recently by E. C. Klotsburger, 1090 N. Glenhurst, Birmingham, general manager of Fisher Body and vice president of General Motors. The appointment is effective on November 1.

Booth has been divisional controller of Fisher Body since September, 1945, and assistant treasurer of General Motors since January 1947.

Starting with Fisher Body in 1923 as an accountant at the Pontiac plant, Booth was appointed resident controller there in 1925. He held this position until 1931, when he was named resident controller of the Atlanta plant.

His promotion to general director of operations accounting in June, 1942 led to his appointment as divisional controller.
