

Oak Park Mayor Talks to Engineers

At the Oct. 18 meeting of the Oakland Chapter of the Michigan Society of Professional Engineers Raymond L. Alexander, who is director of the Oakland County DPW and also mayor of Oak Park, spoke about "future" of Oakland County present and future.

The engineers meet every second Thursday of the month.

Alexander, who is a member of the American Water Works Association as well as the National Association of County Officials, said

that Oakland County is one of the few counties in the state and in the nation to have an advanced sewer planning program.

He also described the new closed circuit television system which has been put into operation to inspect the insides of the County's 1500 miles of sewers.

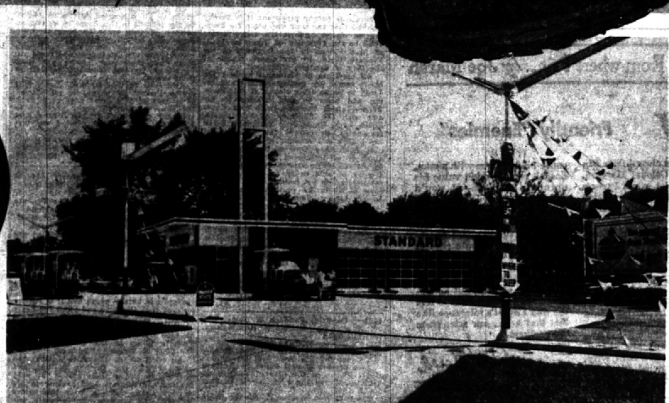
