He has won 17 state and national design awards. He is a member of the Detroit Chapter of the American Institute of Architects and the Michigan Society of Architects.

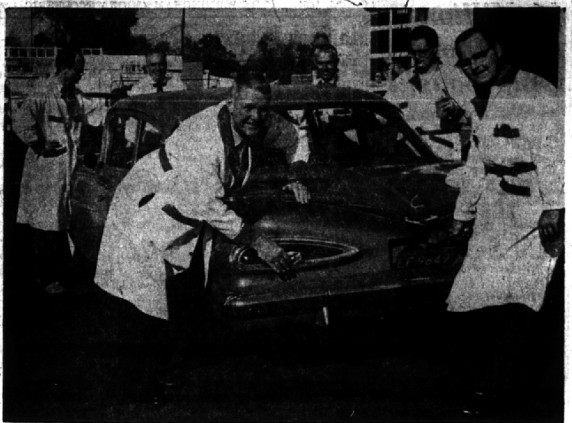

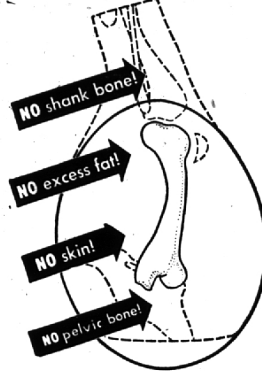
