**U of M Offers
Real Estate
Finance Class**

"Real Estate Finance I" will be offered in Birmingham this fall in the University of Michigan's program leading to a Certificate in Real Estate.

Opening at 7 p.m. Wednesday, the weekly sessions will meet in Room A-101 Seaholm High School, 2436 W. Lincoln Street. Registration may be made at the first class session through Mitchell O. Yentz, class secretary.

The course is offered with the cooperation of the Birmingham Real Estate Board.

INSTRUCTOR WILL be Norman J. Smith, formerly vice president, the First Federal Savings & Loan Association of Detroit.

Smith, who attended the University of Detroit, is currently International Governor of the Society of Residential Appraisers. He has been active as vice chairman, Build Detroit Better Committee, of the Detroit Real Estate Board, and as a member of the Mayor's Committee for Neighborhood Conservation and Improved Housing in Detroit.

"Real Estate Finance I" covers home mortgage lending and is planned for students whose experience in this field is limited, as well as for those with more background in the subject. It emphasizes the legal aspects of mortgages and covers in detail not only conventional mortgage financing but land contract, FHA and GI financing.

THE BEST METHOD of making applications for such loans, the qualifications required of the applicant and the property by the lending institutions, and the procedures after approval of the loan will be thoroughly discussed. Discount systems in financing and re-financing will be explained.

B'ham Scouts End Camping

One hundred and fifty-six Boy Scouts and 21 leaders from 10 Birmingham Scouting units were among the 4,839 Boy Scouts and leaders who camped during the Council's eight-week summer camp season.

Camping ended Aug. 26 at the two Detroit Area Council camps—the Charles Howell Reservation, near Brighton, and the D-Bar-A Scout Ranch, near Metamora.

In addition, more than 100 Scout units held their own camps at state camp areas, or in Canada.

THE ONE MILE Swim Award was a new feature of the extensive water safety and boating programs conducted at both camps. About 250 scouts qualified for this new recognition. In addition, several hundreds of boys were taught to swim, to improve their swimming ability, and to learn lifesaving methods.

Other features at both camps were archery, riflery with qualified

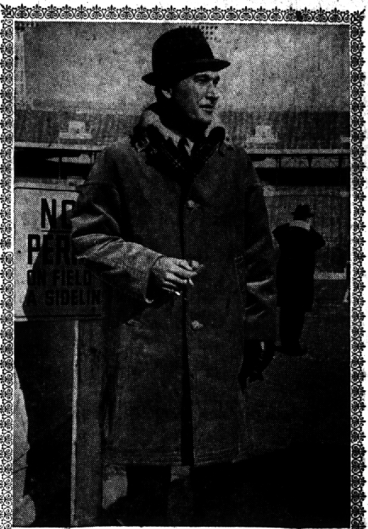
