**Al Watrous Wins Title Fourth Time**

Oakland Hills Country Club golf professional Al Watrous Tuesday won his fourth Michigan PGA Senior championship at Country Club of Lansing.

Watrous shot a 72-70-142 to edge Jim Barfield, Grand Rapids, by a blazing 69, but faltered on the last 18 holes with a 74.

Fighting with Barfield, Watrous was still behind at the halfway mark of the second tour. Then, the Oakland pro birdied the 10th, 12th and 18th holes to go one ahead of his opponent.

Watrous needed only a bogey on the 18th hole to win. He did—and he won.

**COURTS APPROVED**

Birmingham city commissioners approved plans Tuesday night for our new tennis courts and authorized the engineering department to bid bids.

Two courts are proposed on W. Lincoln at Larchlea and two at Crestway Park.

City Engineer William T. Killen estimated costs at \$10,700 for the Crestway courts and \$11,000 for the two on Lincoln.

Commissioner Charles Renfro felt that these estimates were high on the basis of past tennis court construction in the city. Commissioners asked the manager's office for a report on comparison of costs and authorized taking of alternate bids as well as bids on the entire project.

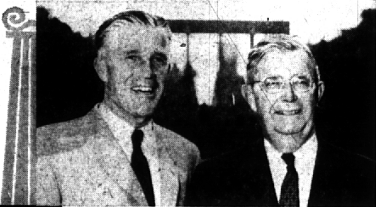
