## New Photo Process Now in Birmingham

A new process used for saving color photographs has recently been added to the stocks at Birmingham Camera Shop, 101 S. Woodward, Dumas, Inc., 141 W. Maple and Morris Stores, 635 S. Woodward in Birmingham.

The process called "Fermacolor" was developed by Berkeley Photo, Inc. It is a colorless soluble chemical added during the processing of the color print which shields the print from the bleaching effect of ultra-violet light.

"According to the 'Fermacolor' people, addition of the chemical does not change the color or the texture of the photograph.
