

# Max Fisher to Head \$18,350,000 UF Drive

Franklin resident Max M. Fisher, general chairman of the 1961 Torch Drive, will head 100,000 volunteers in an area including nine townships of Oakland County, all of Macomb County and all but one and one-half townships of Wayne county.

The United Foundation's board of directors has set a goal of \$18,350,000 highest goal ever set for the 1961 Torch Drive. The drive is to be held Oct. 17-Nov. 9.

Attainment of the goal would bring to more than \$190-million the amount made available, within the past 12 years, for health and community services through the Detroit area drive.

UF executive vice president

Walter C. Laidlaw, said when the goal is reached, an additional \$150,000 from interest on short-term investments would be added to make \$18 1/2 million available for 1962 budgets of health and community services.

THE BOARD also adopted resolution confirming the action of the United Community Services in withdrawing financing from four veterans organizations.

The organizations are the Disabled American Veterans - Wayne County chapter; the Detroit District Association of American Legion Posts; Veterans of Foreign Wars - Wayne County Council and the United Spanish American War

Veterans-Municipal Court Council. The veterans' groups were notified two years ago by the UCS that it was withdrawing support. The resolution pointed out that the Servicemen's Central Bureau has been supported by UF and predecessors since 1923 and that it was controlled by the four veterans organizations through representation on its board.


"HOWEVER, WE as a public organization, have a responsibility to our contributors to allocate funds only where we have proof that they will be used for services which benefit the entire community," the resolution said.

Goals and allocations for this

year's drive include \$411,906 to 25 agencies, primarily in northern Oakland and northern Macomb counties.

United Community Services, a federation of 123 area agencies, will receive \$10,960,888. Michigan United Fund and American Red Cross (four chapters) are allocated \$2,029,280 and \$2,185,293, respectively. MUF includes 35 national and state agencies.

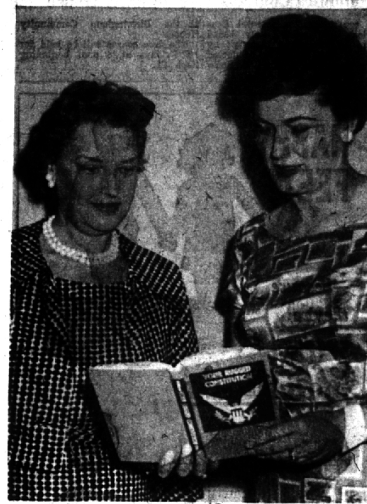
Others on the list of cost and allocations are Metropolitan Detroit Polo Foundation, Michigan Cancer Foundation and United Service Organization.

## Observe Sept. 17-23 As Constitution Week

The Piety Hill Chapter of Daughters of the American Revolution in Birmingham is conducting a campaign in support of Constitution Week, Sept. 17-23.

"WHEREAS SEPTEMBER 17, 1961, is notable as marking the one hundred seventy-fourth anniversary of the adoption of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention, I Florence H. Willett urge all our citizens to pay special attention during that week to our Federal Constitution and the advantages of American citizenship."

The week, according to the Piety Hill Chapter, provides an appropriate time for all Americans to dedicate themselves to protect and defend the Constitution of the United States.

was founded—ideals that have made possible the growth and strength of the nation.
