Art classes are ready to take a trip, with the assistance of Bloomfield Art Association instructor Kathleen (Mrs. Vinton) Birch and maintenance man Ignatz Pinter. Benches and canvases are being moved from BAA headquarters to temporary classrooms in private homes.

Art Association's 'Safari' To Open Fall Series Oct. 2

Anyone sighting a strange safari through Birmingham in October can attribute it to the Bloomfield Art Association.

The "safari" will be a caravan of vehicles transporting artists' easels, art instructors and students to Birmingham and Bloomfield homes. The homes will be the temporary location for the art association's fall series of classes in sculpture, oil and watercolor painting, which begin Oct. 2.

The classes will move out of private homes and into the Bloomfield Art Association's new headquarters about Nov. 1, when flooring, heating and electrical work is expected to be completed there. The new headquarters is Birmingham's former sewage disposal plant at 1516 S. Cranbrook road.

THE "SAFARI" system was developed when the BAA education committee realized the new headquarters would not be ready for occupancy in time for the starting of classes.

Education Chairman Barbara Brook told members, "We must not let the moving and remodeling of the new BAA interfere with our established educational program. If the building is not ready, then we must take measures to insure that the interests of our members and the community are served.

ART association members offered studio and recreation room space in their homes for classrooms.

"SUCH ESPRIT de corps and enthusiasm make it possible for us to continue our educational program without interruption," said Miss Brook.

The ten-week classes end Dec. 7. Fee for all courses is \$25, with a \$3 fee for portrait painting. Registration information may be obtained from Miss Brook at Ma. 6-2169.

Three classes in sculpture composition will be instructed by Sven Kline: Monday morning for advanced students - 9:30 to 12; Monday afternoon for beginning students - 1 to 3:30; and Monday evening - 7 to 9:30. The class is directed toward giving the student knowledge of sculpture media—clay, plaster, wood and stone, and principles of composition.

A STUDIO ART class with Albert Mullen, assistant professor of art at University of Michigan, will be Monday evening - 7 to 9:30, for both beginning and advanced students, and the part-time artist. Individual instruction in materials and form of art will be given. The student may work in pen, pencil, charcoal, watercolor, tempera and oil with still life, figure, or landscape.

Portrait painting and drawing with Mildred E. Williams, instructor, will be Tuesday morning - 9:30 to 12 starting Oct. 3 for the beginning and advanced student, drawing and painting from the costumed model. No specific style or manner is stressed and individual instruction is given.

Watercolor painting with Mary

Jane Bigler, instructor, professor in design and watercolor, Wayne State Univ., will be Wednesday morning - 9:30 to 12 and Wednesday afternoon - 1 to 3:30 starting Oct. 4 for beginning and advanced students. Individual instruction is given and the creative approach to still life, flower studies and landscapes. When weather permits, outdoor trips will be taken.

OIL PAINTING with Kathleen Birch, instructor will be Thursday morning - 9:30 to 12 and Thursday afternoon 1 to 3:30 starting Oct. 5, for the beginning and advanced student. Still life and flower studies, with individual instruction directed toward development of painting individuality.

Water Tank Alley Paving Plans Okayed

Birmingham city commissioners approved Monday night construction drawings and cost estimates for paving a 20-foot wide alley that provides access to the Hunter Blvd. water tank.

Total cost estimate is \$3,700. The pavement will extend from Hunter to one foot west of the west line of the north-south alley at the tank.

CITY ENGINEER William T. Killeen explained that plans also call for placing guard posts and a chain at the east end of the alley pavement to prevent traffic from going through to the east.

Next step will be to advertise for bids.
