Vincent Price Will Visit Hills Theatre

Vincent Price, stage, screen and television actor, will be the "Master" at the Will-O-Way Apprentice Theatre in Bloomfield Hills.

MMFC Approves B'ham 12-Town Bond Issue Plans

Michigan Municipal Finance Commission last week approved Birmingham's request to issue \$1,500,000 in bonds to pay its share of the Twelve Towns Relief Drain. Birmingham intends to sell bonds and use funds already available to pay in advance its entire assessment for the drain that will provide storm and sewer relief for southern Oakland County.

The City expects to accept bids for purchase of the bonds on Oct. 2.

COUNTY DRAIN Commissioner Daniel W. Barry opened the first set of construction bids for the drain at 2 p.m. Tuesday in Pontiac. Other bid openings will be Friday and two days next week.

A total of 22 contracts will be awarded.

Total estimated cost is \$47,500,000.
