

# Police Outline Rules For Safe Bicycling

Lt. Robert Schauls of the Birmingham Police Department reminds residents of the increased number of children who are riding bicycles about the opening of school. "One of the mounting concerns to parents and police is the protection of the children from accidents on traffic lined streets and highways," he said.

"The parents above everyone else," said Lt. Schauls, "should counsel and encourage their children to be courteous, considerate and careful, and point out to them that this is the only 'safe' sensible, and 'safe' way to ride a bicycle."

A BICYCLE IS considered a vehicle, he said. As such, it is subject to vehicle laws. Yet, said Lt. Schauls, very few of the thousands of purchasers and sellers of bicycles and fewer still of the general public comprehend and fully realize this fact.

1. Ride alone - only one on a bike.
2. Yield right-of-way to pedestrian.
3. Ride on sidewalk (see city ordinance, traffic ordinance 238 section 136 states you cannot ride a bicycle on the sidewalk in the case of Woodward Ave. from Brown Street to Oakland Avenue. On Maple from Bates Street to Broadway Street.)
4. Keep both hands on handlebars.
5. Ride single file - keep close to the right side of street and ride with traffic.
6. Be alert for parked cars and opening doors.
7. Keep well back from moving cars. They may stop or turn.
8. Always stop at street before entering from a driveway or alley.
9. Show good sportsmanship to other bike riders, pedestrians and motorists.
10. Obey all traffic rules, signs and signals.

Ten Birmingham area residents will collect information on polio shots from door-to-door in connection with the September Current Population Survey.

THE POLIO SHOT questions, to be asked of persons under 60 years of age, are: Have you had any polio injections or shots? How many shots have you already had? When did you get the latest shot? The polio shot questions will be in addition to the regular monthly inquiries on employment and unemployment. The Current Population Survey will be conducted here in 353 other sample areas of the country during the week of September 18.
