All of the bulbs are TOP SIZE and all of them have been inspected by the Michigan Department of Agriculture. (Not a single diseased bulb was found).

PAPERWHITE NARCISSUS for indoor use.

CAUTION:—
Be wary of BARGAINS at this early date. Bulbs should feel HEAVY for their size. Bulbs should feel SOLID, FIRM. Bulbs should have shiny clean SKINS.

(A few varieties do not produce good skins, and a few always come with considerable gray dirt on them, but these are exceptions—and they are good).

Plant most bulbs now—BUT it is better to plant tulips after the middle of October.

LAWN FERTILIZER:—
If you have neglected the very useful and necessary fall applications of 10-6-4 (or other analyses) we suggest that you get busy. The grass needs to store food for root development in October and November, and early Spring.
