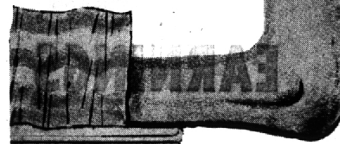


National Club Meets

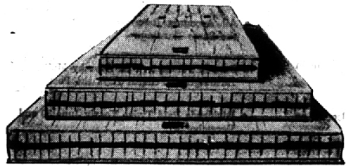
