JOHN ASKED the township board to take action on the petition. Township Attorney Joseph Brennan informed John that the township board had nothing to act on.

He said that had the planning commission voted to change the zoning requirements the township board would have to approve, but in the absence of action by the planning commission the board could take no action.

PINE LAKE Association is considering additional steps to be taken with its lawyer, Jack L. Baney.

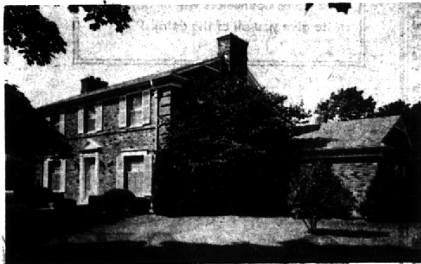
