

## Scout Salesmen Launch Exposition Ticket Sales

Boy Scout salesmen are ringing Birmingham area doorbells this week selling tickets to their Paul Bunyan Scouting Exposition scheduled for June 8, 9, 10, at the Michigan State Fairgrounds.

"Ticket sales kickoff meetings Monday began in each of the 14 districts in the Detroit Area Council, Boy Scouts of America. The meetings are being attended by leaders from over 1500 Cub Scout Packs, Boy Scout Troops, and Explorer Posts who will take part in the sales campaign.

"We expect to sell 500,000 tickets to the show—more than double the number sold for the 1959 version of the biennial Exposition," said J. Patrick Kane, advertising and sales promotion manager for United Motors Service Division of General Motors, and ticket sales chairman for the Exposition.

"EACH BOY WHO sells a ticket to the Paul Bunyan Scouting Exposition is really selling the character and integrity of the Scouting movement," Kane said.

Philip J. Monaghan, General Motors vice president in charge of the manufacturing staff, is general chairman for the Scout-show.

"The Paul Bunyan theme calls for the biggest show in Detroit Scouting history, and that's what we're planning for the boys," Monaghan said. "Ticket sales are vital to a big show, because we intend to set attendance and participation records of which Paul Bunyan himself would have been proud."

THE EXPOSITION will feature hundreds of exhibits ranging from animal care to scuba diving; a colorful Cub Carnival; a huge Indian Dancing Show; an Explorer Road-A-Go-Go and a Pinewood Derby Speedway.

New for '62 will be the Paul Bunyan Trail where Scouts will compete in log-chopping, crosscut and sales promotion manager for United Motors Service Division of General Motors, and ticket sales chairman for the Exposition.

## Army Pvt. Higbie Assigned To New Mechanized Unit

PORT HOOD, TEX. (AHTN)—Army Pvt. David W. Higbie, son of Mr. and Mrs. N. B. Higbie, Bloomfield Hills, Mich., recently was assigned to the newly activated 1st Armored Division at Fort Hood, Tex.

The 1st Armored Division is one of the two new active Army divisions created last February to raise the Regular Army division strength to 16. The division is organized as a ROAD (Reorganization of Army Divisions) mechanized division, one of the first ROAD divisions to be created.

The ROAD concept was developed to meet the need for greater flexibility and combat power in modern Army divisions. Higbie, a radio relay and carrier operator in Company A of the division's 141st Signal Battalion at the fort, entered the Army in October 1961 and was stationed at Fort Ord, Calif.

The 26-year-old soldier is a 1955 graduate of Cranbrook School, Bloomfield Hills, and attended Highland Park Junior College.

## Census Starts New Survey Study of Household Data

A number of local families will be interviewed in a new sample survey to be known as the Quarterly Household Survey which the U. S. Census Bureau inaugurated on April 2.

The primary purpose of the Quarterly Household Survey is to meet increased government-wide needs for additional current population and housing statistics. The increased need for survey data resulted in a workload that could not be handled by the Bureau's monthly Current Population Survey which collects information on employment and unemployment as well as related population and housing statistics.

TWO TO FOUR subjects will be covered each quarter in the new Household Survey. The initial survey will collect information requested by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, U. S. Department of Labor, for a detailed study on the unemployment.

Unemployed persons will be asked questions designed to obtain information on patterns of employment and unemployment in recent years, kinds of jobs held, whether the unemployed persons are willing to move to another area in order to get employment and other work experience items.

A recurring function of the Quarterly Household Survey will be the collection of statistics on expenditures for residential alterations and repairs. Statistics from earlier surveys indicate that these expenditures total close to \$15 billion a year.

THE QUARTERLY Household Survey will be conducted during the first ten days of each quarter in the 375 sampling areas used for the Census Bureau's monthly Current Population Survey. This procedure will enable the Bureau to utilize the services of skilled, experienced Current Population Survey interviewers, simplify administrative problems, and reduce sampling costs.

Quarterly Household Survey interviews will be conducted locally, starting April 2 by Carol E. Barry, 15591 Toyle Ave., Detroit.

## B'ham Graduate Student Receives NSF Fellowship

Richard R. Silbar, 1955 Birmingham High School graduate was one of 20 University of Michigan students who have won National Science Foundation graduate fellowships in the fields of Science, Mathematics and Engineering, the foundation has announced.

He was among 1,750 winners selected from 5,001 applicants. Awards were based on each applicant's score for a special examination, his academic records, and recommendations regarding his abilities. All of these points were evaluated by panels of outstanding scientists appointed by the National Academy of Sciences-National Research Council.

Mr. Silbar, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Robert Silbar, former residents of Birmingham, now of Fenelon, is a doctoral candidate in the Honore H. Rackham School of Graduate Studies in the field of atomic physics. This is the third year he has received the NSF fellowship.

THIS SPRING, Dr. Silbar was initiated into the University of Michigan chapter of Sigma Xi, top honor society for researcher students. He qualified for membership by demonstrating ability for independent research in pure or applied sciences.
