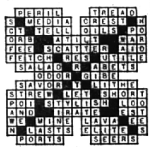
Great Books Series Schedules Dr. Adler

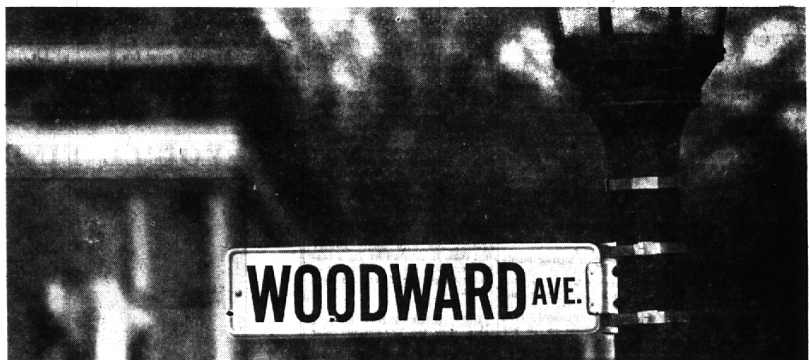
