Daily record books minutely outlining the historic events that occurred during the 15 months service of a Union army captain have been presented to the Cranbrook School Library—its first manuscript material related to the Civil War.

The new collection will enrich the special Civil War material established by the school in 1954 in memory of late faculty member (1928-1944) George W. Patch.

Girl Scouts to Aid Cancer Crusade

The Michigan Cancer Foundation is conducting its traditional crusade against cancer during the month of April, and have enlisted the help of Girl Scouts of Metro-Detroit and suburban areas, including Southern Oakland Girl Scouts, Inc.

Mrs. Milton E. Skutt, Chairman Birmingham District Girl Scouts, gave 12,000 pamphlets to the neighborhood chairmen at their district meeting in the Community House Monday.

She outlined a plan for the girls to go door to door distributing literature describing seven danger signals of cancer and explaining the work of the Michigan Cancer Foundation. The Girl Scouts will also leave in each door a paper bag with a plea for clean white goods such as discarded sheets and pillow cases. They will return a week later to pick up the white goods.

Mrs. Wm. J. Simpson, Chairman of the Service Committee, Michigan Cancer Foundation, Birmingham-Bloomfield Area, explained that when the Intermediate and Senior Scouts appear at your door they will not be asking for funds because the nationally co-ordinated program of the Michigan Cancer Foundation is supported through the Torch Drive's "Give One For All" campaign.

Some Brownies will participate in this service project; however, when they go door to door they will be under adult supervision according to Mrs. Skutt.

Former B'ham Man Teaches Technique To Revive Hearts

A new life-saving technique, which is used to revive hearts that are "too good to die," was taught to Detroit fire and police personnel Monday by a former Birmingham resident, Laurence A. Price.

Price's parents live at 4145 Orchard Hill Drive, Birmingham.

THIS NEW technique, which can reverse death in victims of drowning, electric shock, suffocation, strangulation and other causes of sudden heart standstill, was presented as a public service by Smith Kline & French Laboratories.

Price, who is with the Philadelphia drug firm, is on a nation-wide tour demonstrating closed chest cardiac massage to first and second years in 25 major cities.

B'ham Youth To Attend Safety Rally

Birmingham is among 97 Michigan communities to be represented by an outstanding safety patrol member at the 26th National A.A.A. Safety Patrol Rally in Washington, D. C., May 12, according to the Automobile Club of Michigan.

Some 120 safety patrol boys and girls will make up the Michigan delegation to the annual rally. Individual patrol members have not yet been chosen, according to Ernest P. Davis, Auto Club safety director.

The Auto Club selects the school or schools to represent a community on the basis of their patrol performance and efficiency during the past year, said Davis. Schools then have the honor of nominating their outstanding patrol member to attend.

MIDVALE SCHOOL has been named by Auto Club to send a patrol member to this year's rally. He or she will make the four-day, all-expense-paid trip as Auto Club's guest.

The Michigan youngsters will gather in Detroit May 10, where they will board a special train for Washington. Although the climax of the rally will be reached with a huge parade on Saturday, May 12, youngsters making the trip will be kept busy visiting national shrines and historical attractions in the Washington area.

Three safety patrol heroes will also make next month's trip, John Marozzi, 18, of Warren, Fred Carter, 10, of Mason, and Michael Schaefer, 10, of Ypsilanti. All three were awarded AAA gold medals and the opportunity for the trip when they performed a life-saving act while on patrol duty at their respective schools.

Some 2,500 Michigan youngsters have made the trip since 1961.
