

(Continued from 1-D) but enormously satisfying," says Moran. "The decorative concept was already established — how and where the pieces would go—but each item of sculpture was original in concept and design."

"We were constantly experimenting," added Buby. "In many cases, we were creating objects we had never made before."

ONE WAS a huge brass sun, 12 feet in diameter, that hangs from the ceiling in the center of the interior closed mall. The sun is encircled by three rings of brass. Slender gold rays, decorated with glittering triangles of brass, reach out to the outer circle. A motor in the ceiling keeps the sun revolving. Directly underneath is a large pool with four, tall metal pine trees. Water will come up from pipes in the bottom of the pool, through the rods of the trees and fall down the graceful leaves.

Four other planters hold smaller trees, plants, and birds, throughout the mall are decorative screens and hanging bird cages.

Are the artists satisfied with their effect?

"No," says Buby, lighting his cigarette with the welding torch. "We're never completely satisfied with anything we do. So we try again."

Moran added — "Maybe this is good. You've got to be angry and dissatisfied, keep pushing and

experimenting. That's when the best in art is forced out."

**MORAN AND BUBY** first worked together in advanced styling at Chrysler, designing exhibits and shows for new cars. After four years, Buby left to open his own studio in Detroit where he did industrial and residential sculpture.

His favorite work is a glittering brass rooster which can be seen at Wonderland shopping center, Ann Arbor.

Moran worked on the West Coast in his own studio and in Detroit, concentrating for a long time on animals—such as the giraffe family, and copperplated fish which can be seen at Northland.

For two years, Moran served as art director for "Century 21"—the world's fair in Seattle. Then he returned to Detroit to get back to actual creation of art.

"THE ARTISTS selected Birmingham for their studio because of the tremendously growing interest in art they've found in the area."

"I don't know how or why it has come about," says Buby. "But the interest is right here."

That's why the partners have purchased a lot on Hunter as the site for a future gallery. In the meantime, the barn will be remodeled and opened to the public as "The Bloomfield Gallery."

"It's a funny thing about art," mused Moran. "It doesn't matter whether you're the artist or the collector. The more you get into the stuff, the more you love it."
