**Kirk in the Hills Schedules Final Vesper Service**

The final vesper service in the 1961-1962 series at the Kirk in the Hills, 1340 West Long Lake Road, Bloomfield Hills, will be held at 4 p.m., Sunday, May 6. Dr. Philip Steinhaus will present a special organ recital featuring a new addition to the Kirk's organ, the Trompette-en-Chamade, the only one of its design in the world.

The Trompette-en-Chamade, which achieves the stunning effects of the Royal Trumpeters in the English cathedrals, increases the great Kirk organ to ten divisions. Located in the narthex under the Resurrection window, the trompette's pipes project horizontally (en-chamade) from the stone gallery and are arranged in the shape of a gothic arch. It was created and executed by the Aeolian-Skinner Organ Co. of Boston. Other offices in which trompettes can be found include the Cathedral of St. John the Divine and St. Thomas Church, New York City.

Dr. Steinhaus' program will include a new composition written for the occasion by Richard Purvis, organist-choirmaster of Grace Cathedral, San Francisco, as well as some of the most celebrated works in organ literature.

Dr. Steinhaus, the Kirk's organist-choirmaster-carillonneur, has concentrated extensively throughout the United States and has appeared with several symphony orchestras, including the Detroit Symphony.

He has been guest recitalist at national and regional conventions of the American Guild of Organists. His travels have taken him to Europe and Mexico, where he has studied the design and construction of old organs.

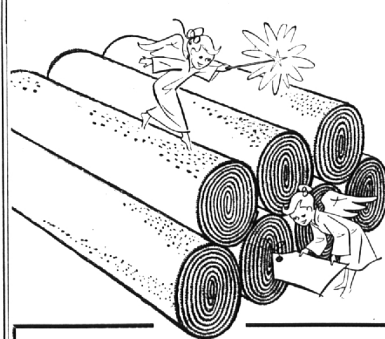

**Election Request On Fluoridation In B'ham Denied**

There will be no election on fluoridation of water in Birmingham, city commissioners decided Monday night.

Commissioners were in general agreement that there was "no purpose to be served" by such an advisory election. They pointed out that the results would not be binding on the commission.

The election was requested by a group of local residents through the action of Walter R. Denison, 114 S. Woodward.

"This group," said Denison, "is definitely opposed to the fluoridation of the city waters and would earnestly seek the recession of the commission's resolution of March 26 recommending to the City of Detroit that the water be fluoridated."

"IT IS ALSO the position of my clients that the residents of the city of Birmingham should be given an opportunity, individually, to decide whether or not they desire fluoridation."

Denison asked the commission to "voluntarily" place it on the August ballot—"so that each citizen might have an opportunity to express his personal feelings and beliefs" on the subject.

Commissioners noted the fact that requests for an election have come only from people opposed to fluoridation. There has been no indication of people who favor fluoridation desiring a vote.
